An Introduction to Canine Hanna Somatics™

The workshop will be led by Eleanor Criswell Hanna, Novato Institute director and originator of Canine Hanna Somatics®.

The topic for the workshop is: AN INTRODUCTION TO CANINE HANNA SOMATICS

Canine Hanna Somatics (CHS) is an adaptation of Hanna Somatics for dogs. Like humans, dogs experience stress and develop chronically contracted muscles. Chronically contracted muscles often create discomfort and restricted movement. Canine Hanna Somatics is hands-on procedure for teaching dogs, their owners, and dog handlers the voluntary, conscious control of the neuromuscular systems of dogs suffering muscular contractions of an involuntary, unconscious nature. Dogs find CHS very relaxing. After the CHS session, dogs walk more easily and their muscles move more fluidly.

The workshop will begin with an introduction to the principles of Canine Hanna Somatics; then Eleanor Criswell Hanna will guide you and your dog through the CHS procedures. Please bring your dog to the workshop, if possible. Dogs need to be at least a year old or beyond, well-socialized to other dogs and people and able to follow directions and become relatively quiet.

Cost of the workshop is \$30 per dog and human; \$10 per observer. The workshop will be held from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., March 24 at the Novato Days Inn, Novato; (415) 897-7111. Please bring a flat bed or rug your dog likes to lay on and a regular leash and collar. Please do not bring recording devices.
